Reflections on: Why We Honour Mary

Many Catholics are asked why they honour Mary and at times some struggle to give a response that is strong enough to withstand the challenge with which this question is often asked. However, we have great examples of why we give Mary the honour that she deserves in practice all around us today. A British journalist covering the achievement of the 'Fastest Man in the World' -Usain Bolt wrote: "When I entered the place of his birth in Jamaica, Usain's mother was brought out to meet me and I stood in total awe at the honour that she received from the people of the village in Trelawny and even from my crew. I could only equate the homage paid to her- to the kind of treatment only someone like the Queen of England would receive at a similar reception." If we honour the mothers of our famous sons and daughters naturally in this way - how much more deserving is Mary of this type of respect?

Catholics honour Mary because God himself honoured her. He honoured her above all other creatures by making her the Mother of His Son. We talk about accepting Jesus as our personal Saviour but we can't accept Jesus and at the same time reject or ignore his mother. During the month of May we should give special honour to Mary and all mothers. We should pray a decade of the Rosary daily to be more like Mary. *A. Moore.*

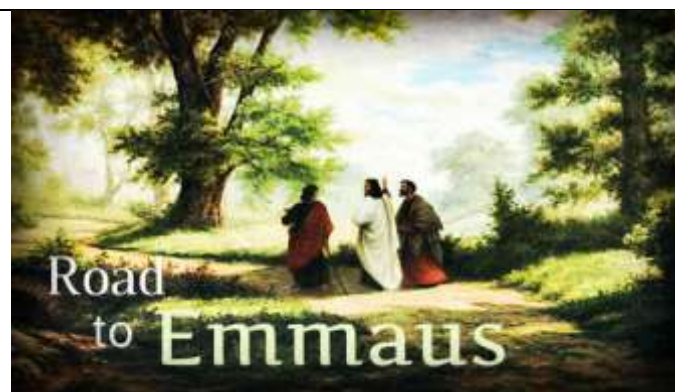
