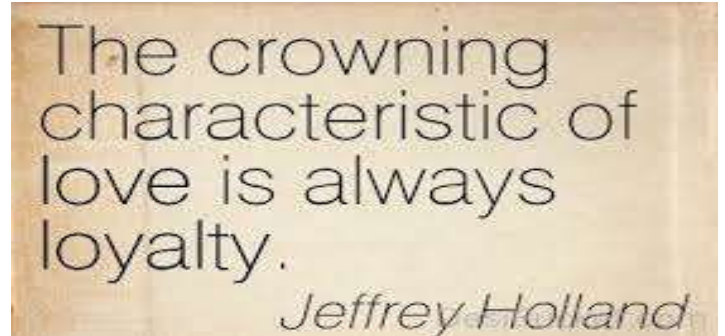
From The Head Teacher's Desk

Our Virtue/ Value/ FOCUS for this week is:

LOYALTY

Thought for the week:

Some people would argue that loyalty is a dying virtue in our modern 'dog eat dog' era. Many would even go as far as to say that trust and loyalty are dinosaur values of the pre-technological age. So why do all of us who are living in the 21st Century still value these character traits? It was Stalin who famously said *"I trust no one....not even myself- and my loyalties are always in line with my own agenda."* Judging from his heinous actions historically, he was absolutely justified in making this pronouncement.
