The Mystery Of The Holy Trinity

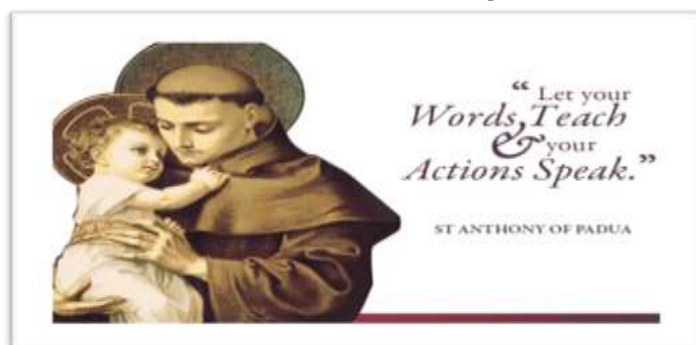
