Each of these virtues is independently important but together they provide the foundations for an inspired life which will positively influence the world we live in" M Josephson

Six Pillars of Character

- **TRUSTWORTHINESS** – honesty, integrity, promise-keeping, loyalty
- **RESPECT** – courtesy, nonviolence, tolerance, autonomy
- **RESPONSIBILITY** – duty, accountability, pursuit of excellence, self-restraint
- **FAIRNESS** – openness, consistency, impartiality
- **CARING** – kindness, compassion, empathy
- **CITIZENSHIP** – civic virtue, lawfulness, common good
