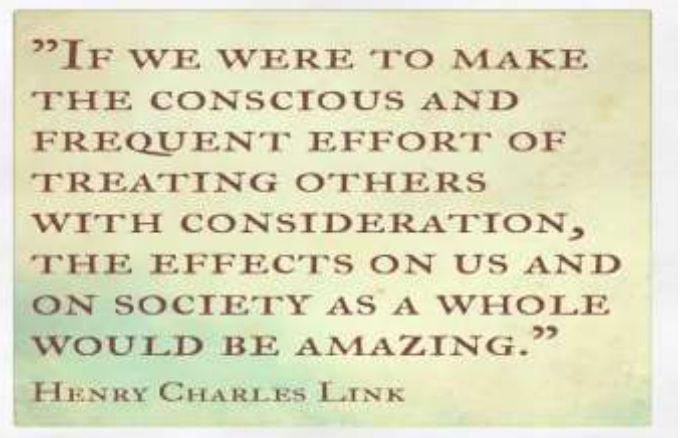
From The Head Teacher's Desk

Our Virtue/ Value/ FOCUS for this week is:

CONSIDERATION

Thought for the week:

"Consider this....be careful with **your thoughts** because **they become your words**. Be careful with **your words** because **they become your actions**. Be careful with **your actions** because **they become your habits** then ultimately, **your habits form your character and your character influences your destiny**" based on Proverbs 4:23



The **Law of Attraction** teaches that we must consciously choose our thoughts to manifest what we desire into our lives. **Why should we be careful what we think? We must, because every word that comes out of our mouth comes from a thought - whether consciously or unconsciously.** We've all had the experience of blurting something out loud which should have remained solely in our thoughts. What we must begin to recognise is that if we perceive it and think it, we will believe it. Therefore, if we believe it... it becomes our reality. This means that we can influence our reality by consciously choosing to think more positively. If we begin to think happy thoughts, we'll talk happy and we will become happier people and as a result we will make the lives of others happier. Conversely, If we are always thinking ugly thoughts, our words, actions and habits will be ugly. Our tone of voice and our **body language** will not only follow the words we are saying - whether sweet or harsh - they will be rooted in our thoughts -which fuel them.
