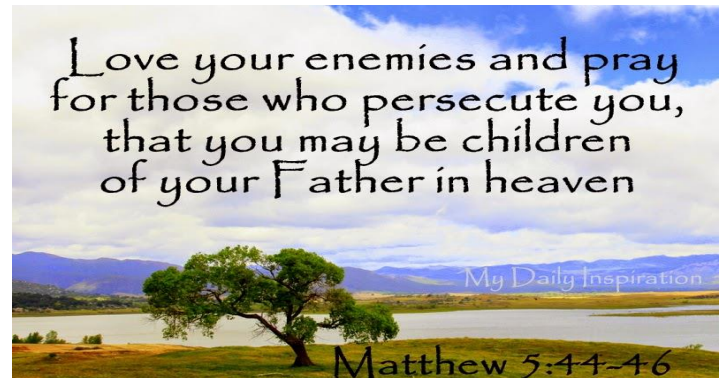
## From The Head Teacher's Desk

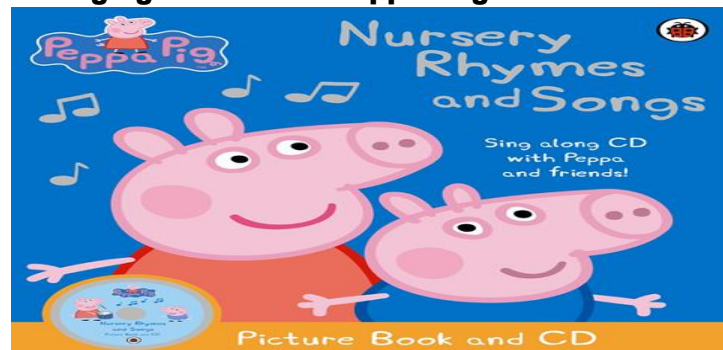
Letters are out today to all parents to seek donations of cakes, sweets, treats and items for prizes for our FUN DAY as well as your time to assist with stall, activities and games.

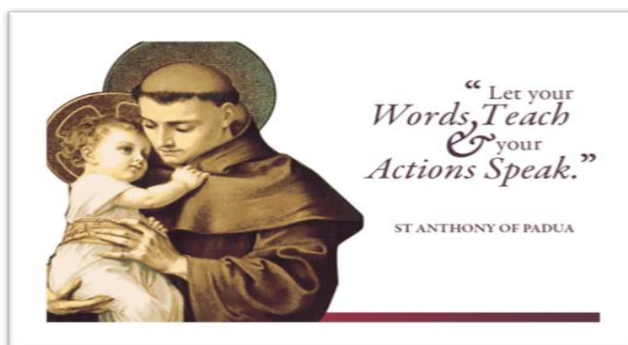
