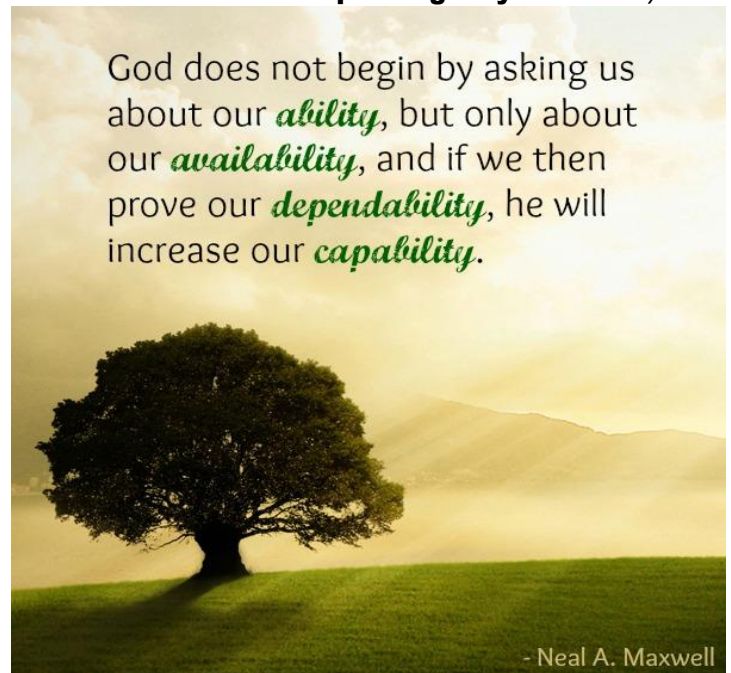

"Being reliable means you take the fact that others are depending on you seriously....particularly the fact that God is depending on you!" *Serenity*



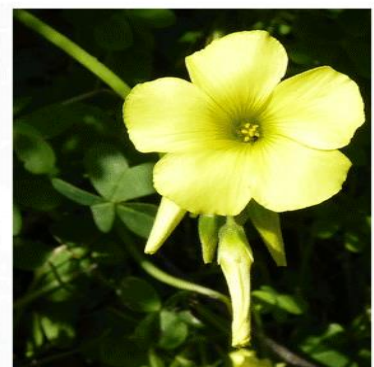
Who asks us to be reliable? Only those who actually count on us daily: God, family, friends, our team & colleagues at work, our faith community...our self!
