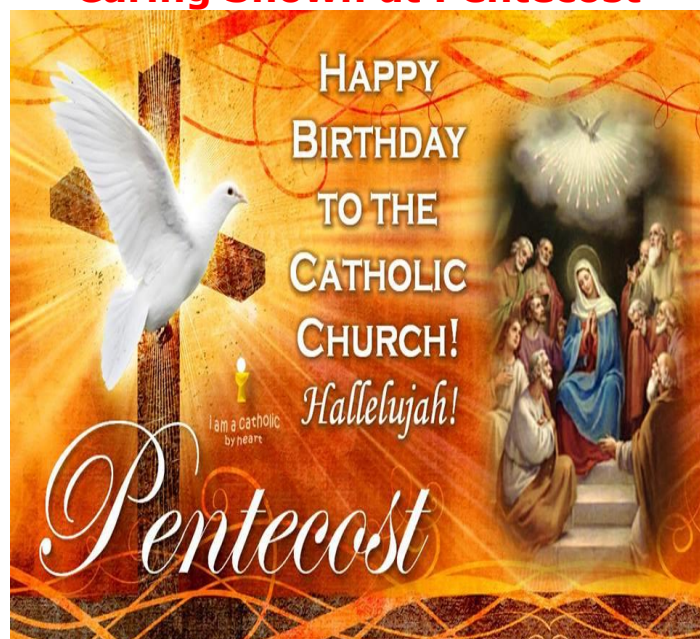
From The Head Teacher's Desk

This week we will focus on the virtue of
Caring Shown at Pentecost



Pentecost marks the end of the Easter season for Catholics and all those of the Christian faith across the world and commemorates the outpouring of the Holy Spirit on the early followers of Jesus.

On Pentecost Sunday, Christians around the world celebrate this holy day, with symbols of the Holy Spirit such as: flames, a dove and images of '**a mighty, rushing wind**' just as the scriptures in the book of Acts described the first Coming of the Spirit.

The first Pentecost was a monumental turning point in Christian history, considered by many to be **the official birthday of the church**. Jesus cared so deeply about His disciples that he promised them that he would not leave them 'orphans' but that he would send the Holy Spirit to empower and enable them.

The Holy Spirit gives us gifts such as: wisdom, knowledge, understanding, courage, patience, reverence for God and humility.

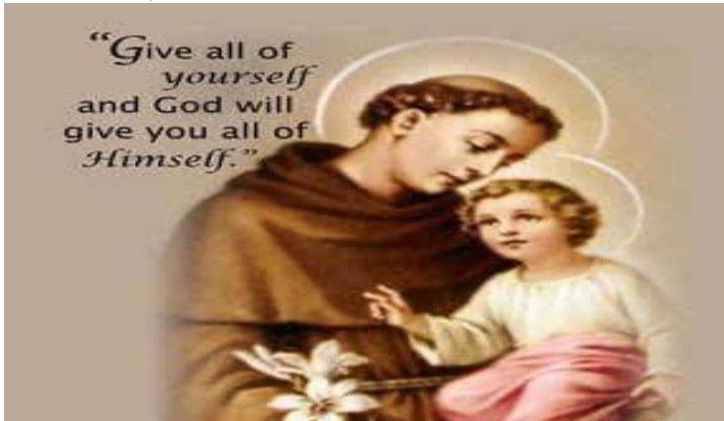
